AALL 2015 FLORIDA CLASS: "The Biology of Sub-tropical Florida"

Many AALL members have already indicated an interest in a Florida-based class next March. Those of you who were not able to attend the last assembly are also encouraged to indicate your intention to register for "The Biology of Sub-tropical Florida" March, 2015.

We are pleased to announce that Jeff Carrier has agreed to two Florida classes next March. These trips are scheduled to occur during March 4-12, and March 18-26 depending on pricing and room availability.

If you are interested in this trip, this is the time to sign up. In the interest of fairness, participants will be determined by a lottery. After the lottery is complete, July 15, 2014, AALL will contact you re: your access to a class. The cost of the trip will be around \$2000 per person and will include air fare, accommodations, travel to the Dry Tortugas, vans for local transportation, admissions to parks and sanctuaries, and most breakfasts. A \$1000 deposit paid by July 31 will secure your place on this trip. A final payment of \$800-1000 will be due in late September.

Flights will leave from Detroit and fly to Fort Lauderdale. The return will be from Orlando to Detroit. The 2015 trip will be similar to last year's with some minor logistical changes. Please note that in 2015, Jeff wants everybody to travel together in the vans for comradery, communication and efficiency.

Even if you indicated you were interested in the Florida Trip at the April 10, 2014 Assembly, we are asking you to sign up again. AALL members who were not at the spring Assembly may also sign up. The due date for indicating your interest is July 12, 2014. Please send your contact information to:
